



### *Summary of consensus view reached at November 2012 workshop*

*This is a listed building at risk. Standard House should be restored for residential use.*

This is a continuation of the view shown in the Standard Quay drawing and includes Standard House and its environs at the farther end of Standard Quay in the direction of Oyster Bay House.

There is a possibility that a footpath closer to the creek up to Oyster Bay House could be created and moorings would be provided along the wharf.

Standard House is an important and distinctive listed building that has a neglected appearance. It is intended that it would be restored and have a remodelled front staircase and possibly new paving.

The adjacent buildings between Standard House and the boundary with the houses in New Creek Road would be set away from the listed building and finished in dark weatherboarding. There was on this site, a previous two-storey black weatherboarded building that was used as a sail loft as part of Goldfinch's yard. It was in the same plane as the new buildings.
